**Turtles must be returned to the same place they came from.**

**Upon registering, your turtle will be given a sticker with a number on it. This will go on the turtles back when the race starts.**

**There will be several races. Approximately 5 – 10 turtles at a time. The kids will stand in an inner circle and set their turtle on the ground when cued. The first turtle to touch the outer circle will be the winner. Judges decision is final.**

**Kids may race their turtle as often as they wish just by going to the back of the line again.**

**We will have liquid hand washing dispensers available.**

Last minute walk entries will be accepted but pre-registration helps us very much with our planning.
