



THE FALLS Theatre

When we were in middle and high school, our after-school activities usually consisted of drives around the county and going to the movie theatre. We'd wait outside in whatever element mother nature decided to throw at us that day whether it be the blistering sun, the pouring rain, or the freezing cold and snow. Everyone would pack in like sardines, squeezing in tightly behind the person in front of us to try to make it into the small entrance. We'd wait our turn to purchase tickets from the small glass booth before bursting into the opening where the snack bar waited. Stretching out and relishing in having regained our personal bubbles, we'd proceed to the horseshoe-shaped counter. Although I was definitely too old for it, I always got the kid's option because it included a convenient little cardboard tray and a little bit of everything - a drink, popcorn, and candy. From there, everyone would march into their designated theatre. I watched so many movies in that theatre. The Hunger Games which is still thankfully producing movies, Breaking Dawn Part 2 when they shocked all of us with their twist ending, The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies where I very loudly sobbed from my seat at the back of the theatre, Spider-Man 2 which I ended up leaving early because the Sandman scared me, and so many more!

A significant portion of my life and childhood happened in that theatre and then the pandemic hit. The world shut down including the beloved Falls Cinema. I was sad but optimistic. The pandemic would pass, I believed it, and we'd get back to watching more movies. But as we all started to get back to a semblance of normalcy and weeks turned into months of the theatre remaining closed, it seemed as though my days of watching movies in my hometown theatre had come to an end. The optimistic note left outside "Reopening someday," became more of a taunt as time passed.

But, in 2022, the hope came back. Phil and Susy Prosapio purchased the theatre and began the painstaking process of returning it to its former 1933 glory. There were bumps and snags along the way, but I wasn't worried. The Prosapios would bring the theatre back as they'd done with many other wonderful buildings and establishments around Little Falls.

It was so exciting to watch from my computer screen as Susy filmed live updates on her Facebook of the renovation process. I'd recognize a poster caught on camera, catch the familiar architecture, and eagerly watch as each aspect of the theatre was lovingly revived. I remember walking into the theatre for the first time a couple of weeks before their opening date. It was spacious, stunning, mind-blowing. I was giddy and practically bouncing off the walls with excitement to see all the new features- the Karamelkorn Shop, a bathroom sink sans the 2x4, the ticket booth, and the many other details that the Prosapios poured over. And I found out that they still offer the kids cardboard trays of snacks! It's truly a sight to behold, and I cannot wait to start making those weekly trips back to the theatre again.





Visit Little Falls is excited to present the new addition of a series of displays located throughout the city's parks as a part of the recent Wayfinding project. The project was funded by Visit Little Falls and Region Five and came to fruition through the efforts of volunteers on The Welcome Committee, Little Falls' students, and Visit Little Falls staff members. The Wayfinding project is meant to improve wayfinding for residents and tourists alike, invite people into the Little Falls community, and help to highlight and celebrate the history of the city and the Native American people.

The displays were created by Adrienne Benjamin, an Anishinaabe (Ojibwe) artist from the Chiminising community. Adrienne is a multi-disciplinary artist, accomplished arts administrator, social justice advocate, and renowned jingle dressmaker. She creates different culturally embedded crafts with contemporary and traditional flair. Her main focus is creating current, socially relevant, and culturally significant work that intersects with Anishinaabe values, history, and lifeways.

The Wayfinding project displays can be found throughout local Little Falls community parks including LeBourget Park, Mill Park, Riverside Park, Pine Grove Park, and Belle Prairie Park. In total, there are 15 Ojibawee Wayfinding displays, each with its own artwork and information.

To help visitors and community members explore and use the new displays, the Visit Little Falls team has put together a map of all the display locations. You can find this map on the Visit Little Falls mobile app which can be found at LittleFallsMN.com or downloaded from your app store.

The Staurolites, better known as "fairy stones," are found at Blanchard Dam. Take Hilton Road (approximately 8.6 miles) to 68th Street (take the path at the dead-end road). These "fairy" or "lucky" stones are twinned staurolite crystals simulating the Roman, Maltese, and St. Andrew's crosses. They are as much as an inch in length and are a dark brown color. The original staurolite mineral has changed to a compact softer material so that the stones can be used for jewelry trade.


These stones are much sought after as good luck pieces, charms, lavaliers, and natural curiosities. Every stone is in some shape of a cross, and millions of people are now wearing them in various forms of jewelry.


The legend of "fairy crosses" has come down through history from the first meeting of John Smith and Pocahontas, which states that the Indian Princess gave John Smith a good luck charm necklace made from a "fairy cross." It is also known that President Theodore Roosevelt carried an amulet made from a "fairy cross."

Locally, there are two popular tales concerning the "staurolite." One states that "staurolite" or "fairy crosses" are the tears of the Cherokee, who wept over the loss of their homeland during the exodus on the "Trail of Tears." The other tale stems from an older legend concerning an ancient race of mountain fairies. This second tale tells of the fairies getting together at their favorite meeting place for dancing and gaiety, only to find out during one rendezvous some 2,000 years ago, that the Son of the Great Creator died upon a cross. Moved by the loss of one so great in the spirit world, the fairies were crushed and cried. As they wept, their tears fell to the ground and crystallized into what we know as "fairy crosses."

What do we technically know about "fairy crosses?" Well, no two fairy crosses ever found are alike. There are three types. The Maltese Cross is a well-formed, perfectly even cross, the most difficult to find, and the highest prized by collectors. The second is the Saint Andrew's Cross, a more common find, with an angled line through the cross instead of a horizontal line. Third is the Prismatic Cross, the easiest and more commonly found, a less-than-perfect shape but crossed just the same. There have also been finds of very rare six-point crosses. No matter what tale agrees with you most, staurolite is becoming scarce due to its popularity.






