## Charles Lindbergh House and Museum

Discover the childhood home of Charles A. Lindbergh, the famed environmental activist, inventor, and aviation pioneer. Explore how ambition, fame, and life on the Mississippi River shaped his complex character. \$10 per person. ♿



## MN Military Museum

Experiences of military men and women vividly captured and interpreted for the public to enjoy. Indoor and outdoor exhibits depict the stories and contributions of Minnesotans who served in all branches of service in time of peace and war, from Minnesota's early years, through the World Wars, leading up to current conflicts. \$3 per person. ♿



## Linden Hill Historic Estate

On a mansion tour visitors can expect to hear many wonderful stories of local history, life in the 1890s-1980s, and will be able to physically walk through the beautifully preserved, nationally recognized historic home. Take a step back in time and become one with history at the Historic Mansions. Pick from four tour options: tour of the Weyerhaeuser mansion (\$10 per person), tour of both mansions (\$15 per person), tour of the grounds (\$9 per person), and refreshments and/or lunch at the pavilion (\$6 per person). Groups of 30+ people will get \$1 off per person per tour.



## MN Fishing Museum & Hall of Fame

The museum isn't just a collection of old fishing items, but rather a collection of historical possessions that belonged to individuals from across Minnesota who are a part of the history of freshwater fishing. The museum holds a priceless collection of fishing-related antiques and memorabilia tracing the heritage of freshwater angling in Minnesota. \$10 per person. ♿

## Pine Grove Zoo

## Charles A. Weyerhaeuser Museum

Patience exhibit showcasing artifacts that show how people in the county lived in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. There are also feature exhibits that are periodically changed. 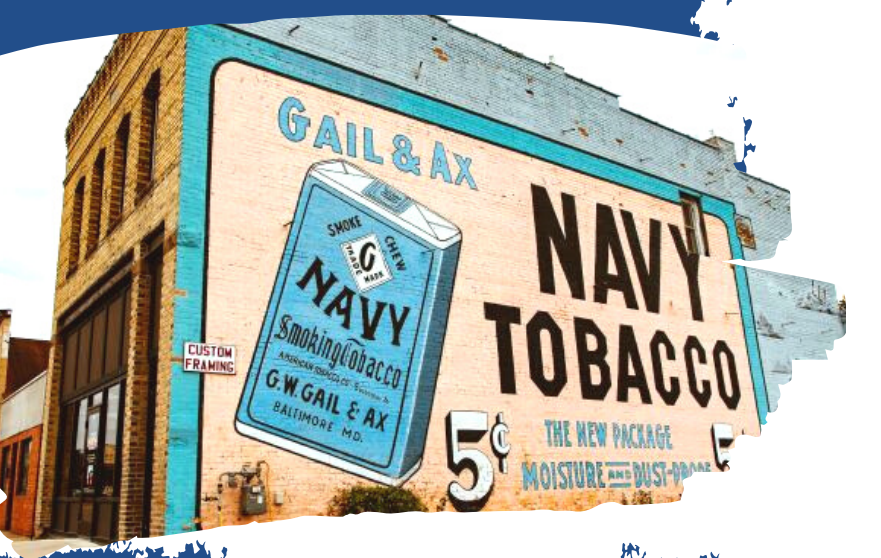
## Great River Arts

## Maple Island Park & Dam
